My ongoing interests in the use of **empty real estate** to stage exhibitions and **Iranian art** collide tonight in a new pop-up space above a Bowery kitchen supply store where Canvas New York Art opens a three week-long show of 24 contemporary Iranian artists ([click here](#) to RSVP for tonight's opening reception). Several of the participating artists are fairly well-known and established, like **Nargess Hashemi** or **Reza Derakhshani**, while many of the younger artists are having their work shown outside Iran for the first time.
